

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOOLWICH AMENDING
CHAPTER 182 OF THE WOOLWICH TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED
“VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” TO MAKE THE INTERSECTIONS OF LICCIARDELLO
DRIVE AND NOCENTINO DRIVE A FOUR WAY STOP INTERSECTION
2017-10**

WHEREAS, from time to time it becomes necessary to amend ordinances to promote the best interests of the Township of Woolwich; and

WHEREAS, based upon a study he conducted prompted by citizen complaints, Woolwich Township Police Captain Sheldon Lewis recommended that a four way intersection should be created at the intersection of Nocentino and Licciardello Drives; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Woolwich deems it is the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of its residents and the Township to amend Chapter 182 of the Woolwich Township Code Entitled “Vehicles and Traffic” to create a four-way stop intersection at Nocentino and Licciardello Drive; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is amended for such purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Woolwich as follows:

Chapter 182, Section 14 entitled Designation of Stop Intersections be amended to add the following:

Intersection

Stop Sign On

Nocentino and Licciardello Drive

All 4 Corners

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Woolwich that this Ordinance shall become effective upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that appropriate signage is hereby authorized pursuant to standards contained in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
