The kit contains pertinent info about your child: height, weight, hair color, eye color, distinguishing characteristics, as well as their fingerprints and a current photo. Law enforcement/Search and Rescue can use this information to help find and identify your child and also enter the child's information into the Amber Alert System. Photos are taken so that they can be easily altered for age progression, making them invaluable if the child is missing for an extended period of time.

Kits are kept by the family in a safe place, and updated once a year with a new photo. In the event of an emergency, everything is available at a moment's notice, reducing the amount of time it will take to mobilize search efforts. It is encouraged to take these booklets on vacation and trips with you as these situations have an increased possibility of separation occurring.

Also included in the booklet are the following safety tips.

- Its' important to have your child memorize his/her name, address, area code and phone number from an early age.
- Teach your child to dial 9-1-1 in case of an emergency. Your child should be taught to ask for help if they ever feel threatened or in trouble
- Never leave your child alone or unattended.
- Inform your child that it is never ok to get into a car or to accept candies/gifts from a stranger.
- When playing outside, encourage your child to play in groups.
- Videotape and take photos of your child several times a year as a child's features change rapidly over a short period of time.
- In the event of an actual emergency contact your local authorities immediately.
- Stay calm, and give a description of what your child was wearing along with the information contained in this ID kit.

Empower your child to trust their "gut instinct." If something doesn't feel right it usually isn't.

To make an appointment to have you child's KidCare ID made you must be a Woolwich Township Resident.
